May's President's Message

Friends,

Passover has now passed over us, and hopefully with it so has the snow! As the weather turns warmer, and hopefully sunnier, I hope you will be reminded of the always warm and sunny atmosphere at our weekly Shabbat services! If you have not been to Shabbat services for a while, please come and give it a try!

This month there will be several community events of note. Sunday, May 5, will be Yom HaShoah. The community's annual candle-lighting ceremony and memorial at 7 pm is sponsored by the Jewish Federation and the Center for Holocaust Awareness and Information. A week later, Sunday, May 12, is Yom HaZikaron, Israel's Memorial Day. A community commemoration, in honor of Israel's fallen soldiers and victims of terrorism, and in memory of the victims of the October 7 Hamas attack, will take place at 7 pm. Then on Tuesday, May 14, from 5:30 to 7:00 pm will be the community's Yom HaAtzmaut celebration of Israel's 76th Independence Day. There will be music, food, family-friendly activities, and live Israeli music performed by the band ROCK.IL. All three events are free, but advanced registration is required. The location of the events will be provided prior to their happening. See page 2 of this Bulletin for registration information.

This month we will also have two congregational meetings. The first will be a special members meeting on Sunday, May 5, at 4:30 pm, dealing with important matters concerning the future of the Congregation. Members should have already received a separate notice with details about this meeting. Then on Sunday, May 19, at 4:30 pm, we will have our regular annual members meeting. At this meeting we review our yearly budget, elect officers and Board members to a new term, review the state of the Congregation, and vote on a proposed amendment to our constitution. A separate notice with details will be sent to members shortly. Both meetings will be held in-person at BHBI. Please make every effort to attend. I hope to see you there!
